For the 6th year, Educational Advising Resource Center seeks to identify highly academically qualified and motivated, financially disadvantaged 10th grade students to join the United States Student Achievers Program (USAP). USAP's mission is to assist highly-talented and determined, economically-disadvantaged Advanced Level students to negotiate and finance the admissions process for colleges and universities in the United States with the aim of producing highly-skilled and widely-educated leaders for tomorrow's Mongolia. USAP works closely with students through regularly scheduled meetings and seminars to assist them throughout the application process to secure admission and scholarships for colleges and universities in the United States. EARC provides free membership to its resource and advising sessions for the participants. USAP expects a commitment of students to give back of their energy and time to the program and to their communities.

Although we do not limit the program geographically, students **MUST** be able to reach our office in Ulaanbaatar on a regular basis during the school year, throughout school holidays, and after exams, for full participation. The students will work with our educational advising staff over this year and the next year to try to secure places and financial assistance to begin study in the US in August 2011.
