




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About the Spotlight Artist

Rune Guneriussen was born in Norway in 1977 and educated at the Surrey Institute of Art & Design in England. His works are site specific and created primarily in natural settings, where he assembles and then photographs installations. As an artist, he believes strongly that art should be questioning and bewildering. Guneriussen has been working with objects such as tables, lamps, and chairs since 2005 and has photographed them on location all over Norway. 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
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
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
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
