- ✚ hold an undergraduate degree
- ✚ have five years of continuous and substantial professional experience
- ✚ demonstrate leadership qualities and a record of public service
- ✚ have fluent English skills (minimum TOEFL 525)
- ✚ at least five years have elapsed since participation of candidate in substantial study in an English-speaking country
